### Pastor Detweiler's Message......

### From the *Interim Pastor* **The Season of Easter**

"For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ who is your life is revealed, then you also will be revealed with him in glory." Colossians 3:3-4

The Sundays of Easter draw us into the mystery behind the verse printed above. In baptism, Paul says in Romans 6, we die with Christ so we can be raised with him. From the time of our baptism, our life is hidden with Christ in God, waiting and longing for the final fulfillment of God's promises in Christ.

Easter is a season of seven weeks that lasts until Pentecost Sunday. It consists of the 40 days during which Jesus appeared to his disciples after his resurrection, plus the 10 days between his ascension and his giving his Spirit to the disciples at Pentecost.

Throughout this time the Paschal Candle, which symbolizes the presence of the Risen Christ, stands next to the altar and is lighted for each worship service. After Pentecost (or Ascension) it is lighted for baptisms and funerals, events that tie us to the resurrection promises. In addition, we use the refrain "Alleluia! Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia!" repeatedly in our worship to highlight the resurrection promises and sing "This is the Feast" as the hymn of praise.

For the season of Easter there are no readings appointed from the Hebrew Bible. Instead, the first lesson each Sunday is from the book of the Acts of the Apostles, detailing the early growth and persecution of the church. The second lessons are all from the first letter of Peter, and detail the hope we have in Christ. The gospels are mostly from John and are a combination of stories of the appearances of the Risen Christ, his teachings and preparation for his ascension to be with the Father.

I invite you to join me in celebrating the resurrection and the hope we have in Christ every Sunday (or Wednesday) of the Easter season!







### **Report of Emergency Housing Program**

The Freehold Clergy Association reports the following:

### Emergency Housing and Advocacy Program

The 2016-2017 season of the EHAP program has hosted 19 men who definitely were the most decorous and cohesive group to date. Many of their situations are complicated and require continued effort. We had three significantly disabled men who the others routinely assisted without being asked. Several of the guests are still offering to assist with anything the program might need. We will hold a post-program evaluation and invite the men, any interested volunteers, and the security guards to provide their assessments and suggestions for the next season.

Temporary housing through shelters or friends have been assigned to several of the men. Five have obtained employment and four are completing paperwork for SSI or SSD. Four of the men have been placed in and/or being monitored in intensive out-patient programs for mental health/substance issues.

Thank you to all who put significant effort into caring for our guests.

# 50 Years Ago - 50 years of History for Hope Christian School

**Rev. Albert Gibson**, founding pastor of Hope Lutheran Church, began Hope Christian School opening in October of 1967 with classes for four-year olds two days a week. Thirteen students were enrolled and the fee was \$8 per month. The church office was the classroom as the education wing had not been built. In 1968 a third class was added with a limit of 51 students and the fee was raised to \$10 per month. The first teacher was **Gloria Kropa** (years of service 1967-1984), followed by **Paulette Stefanik** (years of service 1976-1983) and **Evie Freudenberger** (years of service 1976-2015). As the school grew from 13 children to 51 in a matter of a few years there was a need for more teachers. *Continued on next page*..... The school became very popular and we reached capacity of **156** part-time children. *Nancy Feuster* started in 1983 and worked until 2003, *Sue DellaRosa* taught from 1984 to 1990 and *Linda Adams* from 1984 to 2012. Our school continues to be the best preschool in the Freehold area which has always offered a quality preschool education for toddlers to Kindergarten in a secure, loving Christian environment where they are introduced to learning skills which promote a successful academic future.

Groundbreaking for the education wing was in August 1975 and dedication was in November. Hope Christian School's enrollment **soared** with this additional space. Classes consisted of M-W-F and T-Th morning and afternoon sessions which total **156** students. We were so popular that we had a waiting list every year for many of the classes.

Up until a few years ago, our helpers were all volunteer as well as, our Registrars: **Bev Myers-Leisten, Eileen Kajetzke, LouAnn Lohoff, Pat Maroney, Lori Allerton, Lynda Patrick** and **Anita Foreman** over the years. Our volunteer bookkeepers were **Eileen Kajetzke, Anita Foreman** and currently, **Lisa DeVivo.** 

Groundbreaking for the multi-purpose (Fellowship Hall) addition was held in June, 1985 with dedication later that year.

In **August 2012** we hired **Judy Canfield** as our Director of Programing and Curriculum (now Director - 2016). The school has grown under her direction. We now have a Kindergarten class, the first class graduated two years ago. Several rooms were renovated and a section in our Fellowship Hall was curtained off to accommodate the additional students. Many electives have been added; Spanish, Phonics, Kids in Kitchen and Before and After Care for our children whose parents need to work fulltime. There are now **166** full time and part time children enrolled.

Summer Camp began in 2009 with 14 children. *Amy Chinai* and *Eileen Ko* were the teachers for a half-day program for the month of June. *Judy Canfield* set up a wonderful Summer Camp program in 2013 with something fun happening every week for June, July & August. There have been many young people attending this program and some days, there are over **100 children** enjoying the fun activities that Judy has planned.

**Judy Canfield** is now our **HCS Director**. With these wonderful programs, Judy has hired new teachers, teachers' assistants and Summer Camp instructors. We have a great deal of fun with all the academic programs and the children are prepared for Kindergarten and beyond.
