## PACKING LIST

### WHAT TO BRING

One thing we have learned about Fairview Lake Camp is that at night it is very dark! Please make sure everyone brings a good flashlight. And remember that in the rain it is not a good idea to use your phone as a flashlight. :)

### OFFERING

Each year as a part of this event we take up a monetary offering and an "in-kind" offering. This year for the in-kind offering we are collecting supplies for Safe Have, a ministry of Lutheran Social Services of NY, that helps care for refugee children who have come to the USA without their parents fleeing violence in their home countries. These items are for children ages 2 - 17!

- Small blankets

The monetary offering will be split: 50% for Hurricane Relief in Puerto Rico and the rest of the Caribbean Synod, and 50% for ELCA World Hunger Appeal.
