Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- 1) During the Fall, convene a meeting to plan a Stewardship Program, and execute it during the 4th Quarter.
 - a) Report results to Council at its December meeting
- 2) Develop or revise the Time and Abilities Form
 - a) Arrange to distribute and collect this form during the 4th Quarter
 - b) Ensure that new members of the congregation receive a copy
 - c) Maintain our database of member's skills and interests, and match them to the activities, needs and structure of the Church Council
- 3) Maintain a support bulletin board and provide Volunteer Ministries coordination.
- 4) Provide for new member orientation to the Stewardship Plan for Giving and the Time and Abilities Form.
- 5) Develop, maintain and publish a summary of Church Committees and their membership, for use by the members of the Church Council.
- 6) Consider special appeals that do not fall under other Council ministries and make recommendations to the Council (e.g. World Hunger, ELCA appeals, etc.).
