"HOPE" Fall 2019 Sermon Series

Therefore, since we are justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have obtained access to this grace in which we stand; and we boast in our HOPE of sharing the glory of God. And not only that, but we also boast in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces HOPE, and HOPE does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us.

(Romans 5:1-5)

The Greek word for "hope" can be translated as "expectation." In addition, as a verb, "to hope" (in something or someone) can also be translated as "to trust." Interesting, don't you think?

Because for many of us the word hope is thought of more in terms of a "wish." And, therefore, to hope in something or someone is "to wish" for some result or outcome.

However, the biblical notion of hope seems to be much stronger than that. Again, it's much more of an expectation as opposed to a wish. And, therefore, to hope for something is to trust that it will actually take place or occur.

Hope, of course, is a foundational word for us here at *Hope* Lutheran Church. And so I'd like to take some time to explore it with you during a five-week sermon series beginning on October 27. I hope that you will come and be a part of that experience!



UPDATE ON SPACE ISSUES

In the life of a congregation there are circumstances and needs that create a path leading to a crossroads in determining the future of the church. We are beginning to enter one of those times when what we

decide for the future of our church will effect its members and ministry for years to come.

The Visioning and Planning "Dream" Team, led by Debbie Crawford, had been having discussions regarding the ability of our building to house all the different spiritual, educational, outreach and fellowship ministries we currently provide. The evaluation of the current space present and the potential future needs of our church have been the main focus of this committee.

The committee members have been tasked with creating a wish list of physical enhancements and why each one of those items is needed. This is being done without any consideration of cost at this time.

The congregation council, our church administrator, the Hope Christian school director, and the Dream Team will be prioritizing items and finalizing this wish list. It will be presented to the congregation in the relatively near future for comment and discussion.

A special congregation meeting will be called after the comments are received and reviewed by the committee. At that time, the congregation will be asked to decide if we should or should not proceed to the second phase, formation of a building team, and ultimately the building finance team.

It is important to repeat and underscore to all that the wish list being compiled is not taking into account any financial cost projections. The modified wish list, if approved by the congregation, will be subject to evaluation by the building and building finance committees. The final project presented to the congregation for comment and approval will have been vetter and further modified by architects, engineers, and financial experts to conform all code requirements, site plan restrictions, and the financial capabilities of our congregation.

It is also important during this initial congregation wide stage that we accumulate your wishes, thoughts and hear from every member. Only then can we succeed to work towards our common goals.

We look forward to working with and hearing from all of you as proceed forward.
