

#### Congregational Council Minutes September 19, 2022

Present: Bill U, Brian M, Kate R, Jess S, Judy C, Pastor Ed, Deb, Dave L, Mike D, Sarah, Pat Absent: Steve R, Michelle V, Matt S, Sue H

Jennie Wolf Smith from GSB was zoomed into the beginning of the meeting to review a capital campaign proposal. She explained background of the company. This would be for a capital campaign for the expansion/renovation of building. Advent is not a good time. Easter should be avoided, but we could do it either before or after. Several teams would be needed: Info Team – Inspiration Team – Asking Team – Event Team. Volunteer for each would be needed. The largest group (Asking Team) would need one volunteer for every 10 families. Preschool parents could be approached after our fund raising is done. It was discussed that we need more people who volunteer for all different jobs during service and during the week, as well as for a capital campaign. Brian suggested making up a GIVING TREE – not asking for \$\$ donations but volunteer jobs = small commitments.

August minutes were approved – Motion to accept was made by Mike, and seconded by Pat. Motion carried unanimously. Devotions – Pastor Ed

Preschool report – See attached. School Security Report attached. Council felt we should also think about preparing an emergency plan for weekends – what would we do if a threat came into building during service. Let's aim for November for getting someone here to talk to Council. Council decided to NOT follow through with ADT for additional preschool safety at this time.

Pastor's report – See attached

Treasurer report – Mission fund still has a few hundred dollars after giving away \$20k. Bill suggested that we give it to Crop Walk. Also we have some donations that never stipulated what to use it for. We can use this toward Crop Walk. Seconded by Pat. Motion carried unanimously. Dave answered many questions by Council members.

Mike reported on Accounting Consulting Firm & CPA – Padden Cooper. The accountant search subcommittee (Mike, Rich Topp and Sue Hu) met with Katie Campbell. This company would be third party oversight to make sure that everything is above board and correct. Treasurer, Bookkeeper and Executive committee will talk with this representative and figure out what would be helpful from this firm. Perhaps after the holidays.

Architects: Mike, Bill, Pastor & Brian (members of the architect search committee) met with two architects and are collecting proposals. Two have already submitted proposals, still waiting on the third one. Brian took plans to several well qualified people for thoughts on final cost. Both stated over \$4 million would be more likely to be the final cost. It is VERY LIKELY that our plans will need to be downsized in order to afford it.

Recognition Event – This as become rather complicated since we do NOT want to overlook anyone. Council suggested that we did it by volunteer groups (Education, Social Ministry, Worship, etc). Bill will do the Emergency Housing group recognition on October 23 at the 11am service.

Fund raise discussion tabled to next month Next Meeting October 17 Sarah Devotion






